- 5. Be interviewed by the Scholarship Committee.
- 6. Be recommended by the scholarship committee; recommendations will be presented to the Chapter.
- 7. Provide proof of enrollment to the committee (Example: Enrollment Certificate, Class or Fee Schedule if selected).
- 8. Be aware that all application material will become the property of Houston Metropolitan Alumnae Chapter and will be properly discarded after the selection process.

*The following scholarships require applicants to meet additional criteria outlined below:

The Aster Lee Mock Scholarship and Metropolitan Community Scholarship

- 1. Be an African-American male or female graduating high school or hold a GED equivalent.
- 2. Submit one letter of recommendation from a high school counselor, teacher or administrator.
- 3. Furnish one letter of recommendation from a minister or community leader.
- 4. Submit a typed essay (300 500 words) answering this prompt: *If you had the authority to change your school in a positive way, what specific changes would you make?* Remember: Please be clear and concise in answering this prompt.
- 5. Provide a copy of the family W2 from the previous year to be used in the selection process.



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The Johnson & Cheryl Austrie S.E.E.D. (Self Empowerment through Education and Development) Fund

- 1. Be an African-American high school senior.
- 2. Seeking a career in a trade (Cosmetology/Barber, Mechanics, Welding, Electrician, HVAC, etc.).
- 3. Have a minimum GPA of 2.5.

The Charles C. and Junell Sims Drisdale Memorial Scholarship

- 1. Be a junior or senior undergraduate student attending an HBCU.
- 2. Major in Education or Science.
- 3. Have a minimum GPA of 3.0.

The Hicks-Humphrey Memorial Scholarship

- 1. Be a full-time graduate student in the first or second year of the Master of Business Administration program at the Jesse H. Jones School of Business at Texas Southern University.
- 2. Must be in good standing and enrolled in at least nine (9) credit hours.
- 3. Provide copy of official TSU acceptance letter.
- 4. Submit two (2) letters of recommendation:
 - Professional: expressing personal achievement, leadership qualities, and academic aptitude.
 - Community Based: expressing applicant's involvement and impact within an organization/community
- 5. Submit a comprehensive personal statement discussing work experience, short- and long-term educational and professional goals, how you will use the funds, and why you are the best qualified candidate for the scholarship.
- 6. Provide resume.

The T.O.R.C.H. Bearer Graduate Leadership Scholarship

- 1. Be an African American male or female graduate student at any accredited college or university.
- 2. Currently enrolled within the first three years of a graduate degree program.
- 3. Must be enrolled in a degree-seeking program that culminates in the attainment of a master's, professional, or doctoral degree.
- 4. Submit two (2) letters of recommendation:
 - Recommendation letters should highlight the applicant's leadership skills and qualities.
 - At least one letter should be from a professional reference.
- 5. Personal Statement Applicant should craft a personal statement that meets the following requirements:
 - 350 500 words
 - Provides details of the applicant's professional and leadership experiences.
 - Provides an explanation of the applicant's professional goals.
